The European Commission presents its compliments to the Mission of Ukraine to the European Union and has the honour to propose, on behalf of the European Union, to renew the Agreement on cooperation in science and technology between the European Community and Ukraine, signed at Copenhagen on 4 July 2002, which entered into force on 11 February 2003 and has been renewed on 8 November 2004, on 21 December 2011, on 17 August 2015 and on 17 June 2022, for an additional period of five years, with effect from 8 November 2024.

At the same time, the European Commission wishes to inform the Mission of Ukraine to the European Union that the European Union has completed its internal procedures necessary for the renewal of the Agreement for an additional period of five years, with effect from 8 November 2024. Therefore, should Ukraine consent, this Note Verbale and a Note in reply from the Mission of Ukraine to the European Union would constitute an Agreement to renew the Agreement on cooperation in science and technology between the European Community and Ukraine for an additional period of five years, with effect from 8 November 2024, which shall enter into force on the date of the receipt of the Note in reply from the Mission of Ukraine to the European Union on the completion by Ukraine of its necessary internal procedures.

The European Commission avails itself of this opportunity to renew to the Mission of Ukraine to the European Union the assurances of its highest consideration.
